Growth Measure Selections



All teachers, including those who are anticipated to generate an individual growth score must have a school- or district-level TVAAS composite selection for growth entered in TNCompass.

Types of district and school level composites:

1. School-level TVAAS composites: selected by teacher/leader
2. District-level TVAAS composites: selected by teacher/leader
3. Feeder/Custom school-or district-level TVAAS Composites: selected by teacher/leader and uploaded by district

Achievement Measure Selections



All teachers must have an achievement measure selection entered in TNCompass.

Types of Achievement Measures:

1. State assessments
2. TVAAS School- or District- wide Composites
3. Off-the-shelf assessments
4. Graduation rate
5. ACT/SAT assessments
6. Early postsecondary (EPSOs) exams
7. Industry certifications

Partial Year Exemptions (PYE)

Acceptable Reasons for Partial Year Exemptions

- Educators with contracts of duration of 120 days or less
- Educators who have been on extended leave and have not met the minimum 121 day requirement
- Educators who have transferred to a different school during the year
- Educators who have transferred to another role during the year (Ex. Became an administrator at the semester)



Identifying an educator as PYE in TNCompass



Partial Year Exemption ×

Reason:

Contract duration 120 days or less ▼

- Contract duration 120 days or less
- On extended leave and has not met minimum 121 day requirement
- Transferred to a different school or role during the year
- No longer employed (terminated, resigned, retired)
- Other
