



2022-23 Educator Evaluation Composite Weightings

<u>Chapter 991</u> of the Public Acts of 2022, revised laws regarding educator evaluations by changing the level of overall effectiveness (LOE) calculations. The LOE, also referred to as the final evaluation score, is the evaluation score for an educator that combines qualitative measures, growth measures, and achievement measures. This changes the percentage weighting LOE component for tested teachers, teachers implementing a Tennessee State Board of Education (SBE) approved Universal Reading Screener (URS) and teachers implementing a student growth portfolio beginning in the 2022-23 school year. Non-tested teacher and administrator LOE calculations are not impacted by this law.
