The Tennessee Future Teacher Scholarship is a loan-scholarship program intended to encourage exemplary students to enter the teaching field in Tennessee. Updated Timelines: 2024-25 Tennessee Teacher, Principal, and Supervisor of the Year:

The **updated** 2024-25 Teacher of the Year (TOY) timeline is now available.

- **Dec. 1:** The director of schools (or designee) should submit the names of the district nominees using the <u>district-level Teacher of the Year report form</u>.
- **Feb. 4:** Deadline for nominees to submit the part I application form for review and scoring.
- **Apr. 1:** Applicants notified if they have been selected to move forward to region-level selection.

The **updated** 2024-25 Principal of the Year (POY) and Supervisor of the Year (SOY) timeline is now available.

- Dec. 17: The director of schools (or designee) should submit the names of the district nominees using the <u>district-level Principal and Supervisor of the Year Nomination</u> form
- **Mar. 17:** Deadline for nominees to submit the part I application form for review and scoring.
- April 12: Applicants notified if they have been selected to move forward to region-level selection.

RISE recognizes public school/public charter employees in any of the following occupational specialties: paraprofessional, clerical and administrative services, transportation services, food and nutrition services, custodial and maintenance services, security services, health and student services, technical services, and skilled trades.

Anyone—directors, principals, teachers, parents, students, or members of the general public—may submit <u>nominations</u> by **September 17, 2023.**

Evaluation Data

Evaluation data from the 2022-23 school year has been entered into TNCompass prior to generating Level of Overall Effectiveness (LOE) scores. Please review all applicable components for each educator for completion and accuracy.

Components include:

- Observation average
- Achievement measure selection and score
- Growth measures selection and score
- Student survey score (when applicable)

Individual growth score options include:

- Individual growth single year
- Individual growth multi-year (up to 3 years)
- Individual growth multi-year (without 2020 21)
- Portfolio
- Universal reading screener

All components are not applicable for every teacher.

Additional guidance for reviewing data can be found here. Missing achievement or growth measures selections or selections that did not generate scores can be corrected by an administrative edit. The district must enter Growth Measure Custom/Feeder option scores. The preview window will open September 1 and will remain open **through September 15.**

TN Compass Reports

Evaluation Score by Educator Report: This report allows users to monitor 2022-23 evaluation component scores. The report can be used to ensure all educators have observation and achievement scores in TNCompass before the 2022-23 LOE generation. TVAAS scores used for achievement and growth scores are automatically entered with the exception of TVAAS custom feeder options. Custom feeder options must be entered by the district. We suggest generating this report in Excel.

Growth and Achievement Measure Selections Report: This report allows the user to review 2023-24 growth and achievement measure selections for each educator. This is a quick way to identify educators who do not have selections in TNCompass. The report can be filtered by school. We suggest generating this report in Excel.
