Trouble Shooting

No measure select for educator

- A measure selection can be made by using an administrative edit.
- TVAAS Score (Achievement or Growth Measure Selection) not populating
 - Ensure the selected measure generated a score.
 - If the teacher is staffed at more than one school, set the Master School.
 - Check to make sure the selected measure is a school level measure. If an educator is staffed as system wide, then an LEA measure must be selected.
 - A custom/feeder option must be uploaded.

Growth Measure Selections

- Every educator must have a growth measure selection in TNCompass.
- For most educators this will be a school level TVAAS Composite. A custom/feeder option is available for teachers in schools who do not generate their own growth measures.
- Measure should align as closely as possible to what the educator teaches.
- Teachers staffed in multiple schools may choose a district measure.

Growth Measures

Description	 The quantitative portion of an educator's level of overall effectiveness (LOE) score combines student growth and achievement. The student growth score comprises 35 percent of an educator's level of overall effectiveness. There are several types of growth measures that represent the student growth component: Individual value-added scores (TVAAS) are automatically included in the LOE for applicable educators. For more information on TVAAS, please visit the TVAAS page. Individual student growth portfolio scores are automatically included in LOE for non-tested educators who
	 participate in a student growth portfolio model. For more information on student growth portfolios, please visit the Portfolio Resources page. Individual alternative growth measure (AGM) scores via a Tennessee state board approved universal reading screener are automatically included in the LOE for K-2 educators who participate in an AGM. For more information on state board approved universal reading screeners, email tn.universalscreener@tn.gov. For more information on alternative growth measures, visit the Alternative Growth Measures page. School, district, and custom composites are uploaded by the district for applicable educators. 2023-24 Growth Measure Selection Guidance

Selection of Student Growth Measures Fall 2023

The quantitative portion of an educator's level of overall effectiveness (LOE) score combines student growth and achievement. While the selection of growth measures is a local decision, the purpose of this guidance is to provide clarity regarding the measures available, the composition of those measures, and the questions that might lead to an appropriate and available selection for each educator.

Types of Growth Measures

- 1. Individual value-added scores (TVAAS): automatically included in LOE for applicable educators
- 2. Individual student growth portfolio scores: automatically included in LOE for applicable educators
- Individual State Board approved Universal Reading Screener scores: automatically included in LOE for applicable educators
- 4. School-level TVAAS composites: selected by teacher/leader (listed in subsequent section)
- 5. District-level TVAAS composites: selected by teacher/leader (listed in subsequent section)
- 6. Feeder/Custom school- or district-level TVAAS Composites: selected by teacher/leader and uploaded by district (listed in subsequent section)

All teachers, including those who are anticipated to generate an individual growth score (type 1, type 2 and type 3 above), must have a school- or district-level TVAAS composite (types 4-6 above) selection for growth entered in TNCompass.

School, District, and Feeder/Custom Measures

During the fall, educators (in consultation with the school leader) must select a growth measure that is most closely aligned to their work. Leaders should confirm during selection that the growth measure will generate a score for the educator to use.

Note: The feeder/custom option may be selected for educators who work at a school that does not generate school-level TVAAS. Here are some examples for which a feeder/custom ordistrict option might be appropriate:

- Educators in a K-2 school may select a TVAAS school composite for the feeder school where the students will attend.
- Educators who serve multiple schools within the district may select a TVAAS district composite.

Achievement Measure Selections



- Every educator must have an achievement measure selection in TNCompass.
- Achievement measure options include State Assessments, Off the Shelf Assessments, TVAAS Composites, Graduation Rate, ACT/SAT assessments, Early Post-Secondary Exams and Industry Certifications.
- Measure should align as closely as possible to what the educator teaches.
- Achievement measure criteria must be set when the selection is made.

Achievement Measure Selections

Achievement Measure Categories:

- TVAAS School- or District- wide growth measures may be used as achievement measures. These do not require setting measurable criteria.
- State assessments include assessments in math, English language arts, social studies, and science. They also include alternate assessments, MSAA and TCAP-Alt.
- Off-the-shelf assessments are intended to provide a measure of achievement for teachers in non-tested grades and subjects for evaluation purposes.
- Graduation rate is an appropriate measure for high school educators.

Achievement Measure Selections

Achievement Measure Categories:

- ACT/SAT assessments are required postsecondary readiness assessments.
- Early postsecondary (EPSOs) exams provide the opportunity for students to earn postsecondary credit while in high school.
- Industry certifications are earned through secondary and postsecondary career and technical education programs and courses.

Setting Achievement Measure Criteria

- The process for setting achievement measure criteria is a local level decision.
- Administrators and teachers should discuss these targets to ensure that they are specific, measurable, and attainable within one year.
- TVAAS measures do not require criteria.
- As a reminder, level 3 should be "At Expectations" for one year of performance.
 - Annual measurable objectives (AMOs) are yearly targets for improving performance based on prior-year results. Available on the Accountability Application at the school and district level, these targets are based on the expectation that the percentage of students not meeting the standard is to decrease by half in eight years. AMO targets are rounded to one decimal place. Double AMO targets are based on the expectation that the percentage of students not meeting the standard is to decrease by half in four years. A district can request subject and grade level AMOs by contacting <u>TNED.Accountability@tn.gov</u>.

Before you begin your training, download the <u>facilitator guide</u>. This guide will help you in understanding the pattern of the presentations and suggestions for faculty training sessions or PLC meetings.



How to use it:

Standards and Objectives

Standards and objectives should be the first indicator the teacher focuses on when planning a lesson or unit.

The key to being effective with the standards and objectives indicator is a clear understanding by the teacher and the students of the learning that is taking place during the lesson.

- The teacher is clear on what they want students to know and be able to do as a result of the lesson.
- The teacher clearly communicates to students the expectations for the daily objective. Student understanding of the objectives is evident in the aligned student work.

Evaluator Expectations

In the pre-conference ask, "To what standard is the objective aligned?"

- In order to score this indicator, the observer will need to Identify what the teacher wants the students to know and
 - be able to do,
- review the student work,
- identify thinking in the student performance,
- and analyze student work for evidence of mastery of the lesson objective.

This indicator supports the effectiveness of all other indicators.

Descriptor 1: Learning objectives are communicated, connected to the state standard(s), and referenced throughout the lesson.

This descriptor pertains to the teacher's ability to communicate the lesson objective, connect the objective to the overall standard, and reference the objective throughout the lesson. Learning objectives must be clearly written before they can be clearly communicated. This also provides purpose for what takes place during a lesson

There are three components of a clearly communicated objective:

- 1. Observable verbs/actions
- 2. Clear description of learning outcomes
- 3. Reference to objective throughout and at the end of the lesson
