Growth Measure Selections



All teachers, including those who are anticipated to generate an individual growth score must have a **school-level TVAAS composite** selection for growth entered in TNCompass.

Types of school level composites:

- 1. School-level TVAAS composites: selected by teacher/leader
- 2. Feeder/Custom school-level TVAAS Composites: selected by teacher/leader and uploaded by district Note: Feeder/Custom Composites are only used if a school does not generate TVAAS Composites.

Achievement Measure Selections



All teachers must have an achievement measure selection entered in TNCompass.

Types of Achievement Measures:

- 1. State assessments
- 2. TVAAS School-wide Composites
- 3. Off-the-shelf assessments
- 4. Graduation rate
- 5. ACT/SAT assessments
- 6. Early postsecondary (EPSOs) exams
- 7. Industry certifications

Scores for TVAAS School-wide Composites are automatically loaded into TNCompass.

TVAAS Custom/Feeder Composites and all other achievement scores must be entered by the district. Note: Feeder/Custom Composites are only used if a school does not generate TVAAS Composite.





Monitoring Pacing


State Board of Education Policy 5.201 outlines the minimum requirements for pacing.

Licensure Status	Previous Year Individual Growth or Level of Overall Effectiveness ²	Minimum Required Observations*	Minimum Required Observations per Domain*	Minimum Number of Minutes per School Year
Practitioner	Levels 1-4	All domains observed, with a minimum of three (3) domains observed in each semester and a minimum of three (3) formal observations.	3 Instruction 2 Planning 2 Environment	90 minutes
	Level 5	One (1) formal observation covering all domains first semester; two (2) walk- throughs second semester.	1 Instruction 1 Planning 1 Environment	60 minutes
	Level 1	All domains observed, with a minimum of three (3) domains observed in each semester and a minimum of three (3) formal observations.	3 Instruction 2 Planning 2 Environment	90 minutes
Professional	Levels 2-4	All domains observed with a minimum of two (2) domains observed in each semester and a minimum of two (2) formal observations.	2 Instruction 1 Planning 1 Environment	60 minutes
	Level 5	One (1) formal observation covering all domains first semester; two (2) walk-throughs second semester.	1 Instruction 1 Planning 1 Environment	60 minutes

² LEAs may elect to base pacing on a teacher's previous year individual growth or on level of overall effectiveness, pursuant to local policy.

Monitoring Pacing

Pacing can be monitored using the Pacing Guide Report from TNCompass for Charter Schools who use the TEAM Rubric and enter observations directly into TNCompass.




Partial Year Exemptions (PYE)

Acceptable Reasons for Partial Year Exemptions

- Educators with contracts of duration of 120 days or less
- Educators who have been on extended leave and have not met the minimum 121 day requirement
- Educators who have transferred to a different school during the year
- Educators who have transferred to another role during the year (Ex. Became an administrator at the semester)
- Educators who leave the district/charter before the end of the school year.

Identifying an educator as PYE in TNCompass





Next Steps



- Upload any missing growth or achievement measure selections.
- Monitor observations to ensure pacing is met.
- Identify any educators who should be PYE.
- Upload achievement measure scores as they become available. Scores for TVAAS School-wide Composites are automatically loaded into TNCompass. Note: TVAAS Custom/Feeder Composites and all other achievement scores must be entered by the charter.
