Portfolio Score/ Teacher Growth Score

The portfolio score is calculated by averaging the four evidence collection growth scores.

The portfolio score is applied to the chart to determine the Teacher Growth Score. This is the educator's growth score that serves as 35 percent of the LOE.

Portfolio Score	Teacher Growth Score
1.00 – 1.79	1
1.80 – 2.59	2
2.60 – 3.39	3
3.40 – 4.19	4
4.20 – 5.00	5

If the Portfolio Status is Incomplete, the teacher will be assigned Incomplete for the growth score in TNCompass and the teacher's LOE (Level of Overall Effectiveness) score will NOT generate for the school year.

- Teacher Self Score- student growth from the teacher's own self scoring
- Peer Reviewer 1 Score- student growth from the 1st reviewer
- Peer Reviewer 2 Score- student growth from the 2nd reviewer, when applicable
- Expert Reviewer Score- student growth from the expert reviewer, when applicable
- Final Student Growth Indicator Score

Collection Score Calculation

The collection score is calculated by finding the difference between Point A and Point B scores for each student work sample in the collection and then determining an average level of student growth for that collection. The average level of student growth for the evidence collection is then applied to the Student Growth Indicator values in the chart.

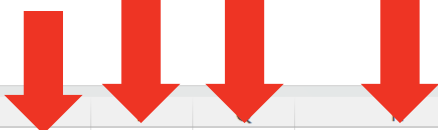
Student Growth Indicator Chart	
Level 5 Significantly Above Expectations	Students demonstrate, on average, three or more levels of student growth (= or >3 levels of growth).
Level 4 Above Expectations	Students demonstrate, on average, two levels of student growth, but less than three levels of student growth (=2 levels of growth, but < 3 levels of growth).
Level 3 At Expectations	Students demonstrate, on average, one, but less than two levels of student growth (=1 level of growth but <2 levels of growth).
Level 2 Below Expectations	Students demonstrate, on average, less than one level of student growth (>0 levels of growth but <1 level of growth).
Level 1 Significantly Below Expectations	Students demonstrated, on average, no growth or negative growth.



Sample Report

This report allows Portfolio District Admins to view details about teacher sample submission scores. This report will have one row per Portfolio User + Submission + score.

- Review Number- Which review this is (i.e. teacher self review, first review, second review, expert review). Options are: Teacher, 1, 2, 3 (Expert)
- Point A Score The rubric score given for Point A of this sample (Note: If it was marked not scorable, list 'Not scorable')
- Point B Score The rubric score given for Point B of this sample (Note: If it was marked not scorable, list 'Not scorable')
- Reviewer Feedback- If the Sample was 'not scorable', the reason should be listed here
